Lengthman & Parish Path Partnership [P3] Schemes

Monthly Report : April 2016

Dear Councillors,

Plans to take up a new L/P3 Contract were discussed at our April CPC Meeting . After much hassle , the final figures for expenditures have been obtained from B-B and a summary is detailed below .

Since mid-March , no L/P3 work has been carried out and cannot recommence until a new Contract and a Lengthsman are in place , In the meantime , B-B have been kept informed of events and have taken over the work in the parish until such time as CPC can recommence the work . As Scheme Administrator , I continue to liaise with our Locality Steward [Cathy Berkeley] for the sake of good order and continuity .

[1] Final Statement for 2015 -2016 L/P3 Grant expenditure:

To the best of my knowledge the figures below are now correct and effectively sign off the 2015 -2016 Contract between CPC and B-B /HCC .

Conclusion:

- Total Expenditure for 2015 -2016 was £ 5638
- NO Match Funding Required
- The Expenditure figures cover all Labour, Material and set up Equipment costs
- Note that the schemes did not fire up until June 2015 [ie c. 9 months work]

[2] 2016-17 L/P3 Contract:

Further to CPC's authorisation [at March 2016 CPC Meeting] to proceed to arrange a new 2016 -2017 L/P3 Contract with B-B /HCC, I can report that the Contract has now been signed by our Chairman and Clerk and has been sent to B-B for approval and the HCC Seal. Also, a 2016-17 Annual Maintenance Plan and Grant Funding application has been submitted.

When these are duly returned, it will be possible to put the appointment of a Lengthsman for 2016 17, out to tender in order to obtain best value for money.

[3] Full Funding of Scheme from 01 04 2017 :

Councillors will recall that at our last meeting I sought CPC support for the L/P3 Schemes going forward with PC full funding from the start of year 3 [ie From 1st April 2017]. However, this was discussed but held over pending the AGM of CPC in May.

At the AGM I will again be seeking Council support for Year 3 funding . Below , I estimate the likely implications for the funding via the Cradley Parish Precept .

We could envisage the recruitment of either

[a] A skilled Lengthsman . [Fully qualified and able to provide his own suitable vehicle , tools and equipment , storage]

[b] An unskilled Lengthsman [Ken , willing to learn and up-skill , fit , with a practical bent]

Hourly pay rates would reflect the options

Estimated costs of the schemes [L/P3]

Budgeting Costs based upon experience of 2015-16:

- Say 48 weeks pa worked at 1day per week = 48 days Labour pa
- Average 7Hrs /day
- Average £150 per month Materials
- Labour Rate /Hr [a] Unskilled £10 £12 p/hr, say £11 /hr average
 [b] Skilled £18 -20 p/hr, say £19 p/hr average

Cost to CPC per annum:

	<u>Option</u>	Labour Cost	<u>Materials</u>	TOTAL
[a]	Skilled	£ 6384	£1800	£8184
[b]	Unskilled	£ 3696	£1800	£5496

However, CPC already has £2000 pa built into the Precept so the additional amounts needed to be added to the Precept from April 2017 would be either [a] £6184 or [b] £3496 dependent upon which route was taken.

NB If an unskilled person was appointed then the PC would need to provide training and equipment costs and in this event, the likely costs would increase towards the costs of a skilled Lengthsman by the end of the 3rd year.

To conclude, 2015-2016 is completed and grants from B-B are in the kitty.

CPC must now provide guidance / approval of the forward plans for the Lengthsman /P3 schemes which enables the council to hire a Lengthsman in the full confidence that the scheme will continue into 2017-2018, knowing that the whole community has been nothing but supportive and appreciative of the work already done in the parish.

A CPC commitment is essential for the scheme to go forward
