Monthly Report : February 2016

Dear Councillors,

As I write this summary of our work during February the weather conditions have at last improved somewhat and Rob and I have been able to make good progress with the backlog of pothole repairs and highway maintenance.

We hope to have caught up on the bulk of the pothole work which we are permitted to carry out by the end of March .

I am pleased with the standard of our pothole repairs and invite fellow councillors to take a close look at our work and report back. Our repair techniques should ensure that water ingress is eliminated, the surfaces are level and well compacted and the joints have all been sealed with a bitumous compound ... proper job! They will last a long time.

Storridge lanes have had their share of attention as well and all being well we hope to now keep on top of the pothole work .

PROW work has been minimal in Feb but we start again on footpath work in early March .

I am pleased to report that we have been getting excellent support from our Locality Steward but not so her employer, Balfour – Beatty.

You will recall that last month I reported that I hoped to be able to sort out logistics and accountancy and modus operandii with B- B. I wrote then
