Monthly Report : March 2017

Dear Councillors,

This month, March, brought us to the end of the 2016 2017 Financial year. Our Lengthsman Jeremy has completed some nine months work, having commenced work in July 2016. Jeremy has been a real revelation, bringing great experience of the work, total commitment to our Cradley Parish and a wonderful work ethic and flawless integrity. We are blessed with such a rare asset. I cannot speak too highly of him. He always goes the extra mile to get the work done and is a delight to work with.

The weather proved to be fickle indeed during the month and not best suited to good pothole repair work. However, my April report will confirm that that month got off to a good start with the re-commencement of essential pothole repair work. In March we have concentrated on PROW work and made excellent progress.

The Lengthsman Scheme has begun work on the recreation areas and these will feature, henceforth, in my reports.

On the Lengthsman front:

- Huntingdon: completed the fence repairs, painting and strimming work
- At Rectory Lane / C1162, the final [sixth] Dog Bin has been erected and commissioned. The
 forecast total weight of waste collections is estimated to be around 700-750 kg per annum based
 upon the first 6 month monitoring.
- Sided out kerbways at The Leys [C1162]
- Buryfields Rec Area: taken control of Litter Bin management. Site survey of R&M needed and plan developed.
- U65627 [Vinesend Lane] . Carried out grip cutting and drainage work [WIP]

PROW work:

- CD-51 New signage at A4103 Junction, near New INN
- CD-78 Removed old bridge remains and constructed new 16'-0" footbridge, midway twixt A4013 and Beanhouse Farm [Big Job]. All heavy materials and equipment manually carried to site [approx. . 1 tonne carried . circa total trek of some 5-6 miles]. Now back in use having been painted, new steps and new waymark post.
- CD-41 . Jeremy continued the WIP as a solo effort and has almost broken through to the top ridge .
 We should soon be able to get the Bridleway from Upper Vinesend to the top of the ridgeway path back in equine use . A real achievement . difficult , heavy work .
- CD-36 . Logged up and cleared fallen trees on the path above Church Stile Farm .
- CD-31A Strimmed the whole length of this footpath which adjoins two sides of the Buryfields Recreation Area.

ps Reports are coming in currently that the winter conditions have created a significant number of new potholes on the Coombe Lane and Suckley roads especially Greenhill and Halesend areas. I plan to engage with our Locality Steward ,soon , to get a plan for repairs based upon shared work between CPC and B-Beatty .
