Pragmatism and common sense are the reasons why the old L/P3 Scheme and the work of the old Recreation WG have now been combined into the newly titled Village Infrastructure WG. De facto, for 6 months now, GT, DS and GF have run the old recreation WG together with the L/P3 work.

The budgets are running together and the work schedules are completely inter-twinned. So my reports henceforth will cover all the work that is carried out under the general title of Village Infrastructure WG.

From 1st April 2018, we loose the HCC Lengthsman Grants so the budgetary work in preparation for the 2018-19 Precept proposal will, for the VIWG be a unified proposal, this will also help everyone to more clearly comprehend both the budgets and the work to maintain Cradley and Storridge Parishes.

September has been a very busy month for your team . We are proud to have completed a significant amount of tasks and even managed to find an excellent storage facility at Buryfields for all our road signage , pothole materials , PROW goods etc .  - 1. Cut back the full length of the overgrown hedge line [Bonfire for later in year]
 - 2. Strimmed the adventure Play area
 - 3. Trimmed the roadside hedge and verges .
 - 4. Cleared litter bins
 - 5. Arranged and supervised urgent mole-catching programme
 - 6. Been to HCC / Archive Centre to retrieve PC land title deeds [re boundary hedge ownership matters] .
