Working Groups Operational Guidance

- 1. The Membership of Working Groups will be appointed at the Annual meeting of Full Council in May. If any councillor resigns from a working group, then the working group can fill the place with another councillor or a newly elected councillor.
- **2.** The Lead of the Working Groups will be appointed at the Annual meeting of Full Council in May.
- **3.** Working Groups should ideally consist of 3 councillors, but should as a minimum be <u>not</u> less than 2 councillors and as a maximum <u>not</u> exceed 50% minus one of the total number of Councillors on Council.
- **4. No** councillor should be on more than 50% of the total number of Working Groups.
- 5. Lay Members must be approved by Full Council before serving on a Working Group.
- **6.** Lay Members have **no** voting rights on the Working Group.
- **7.** Working Groups <u>must</u> submit all reports and requests to Full Council for Consideration and discussion within a week prior to Full Council.
- **8.** Working Groups have <u>no</u> authority to offer any Grants or any financial assistance.
- **9.** The Lead of the Working Group will have the casting vote if necessary.
- **10.** All working groups to review and update the group's individual risks.
- **11. No** working group as the authority to appoint or approve contracts or contractors.
